Doula Services Agreement

Updated: March 8, 2011

WHAT IS A DOULA?

A doula is an experienced birth assistant who provides parents-to-be with physical, emotional and informational support throughout pregnancy, labour, birth and post-partum. A doula recognizes birth as an important life experience that will have a lifelong impact on the health of both the mother and child. Her main role is to help parents-to-be identify what they define as a positive birth experience and help them achieve this.

Parents-to-be should meet with a potential doula at least once before committing to a professional relationship to become acquainted, discuss their priorities and concerns, and to plan how they can best work together. This meeting does not obligate them to use the doula's services.

RACHEL SCHWARTZMAN, ND'S SERVICES AS A DOULA INCLUDE:

- Two, 60 minute in-office prenatal appointments
- Labour and birth attendance
- One, 60 minute postpartum home visit or telephone consultation

Initial appointment:

The first appointment is used to review your reasons for hiring a doula and to determine how you and your partner foresee working together, and with Rachel Schwartzman, ND at the birth. Discussion will include preparation of a birth plan (including preferences regarding use of pain medication and how the mother-to-be best copes with pain and fatigue), and labour and birthing resources. The initial consultation should be scheduled at anytime during the first or second trimester of pregnancy.

Second appointment:

The second appointment is used to review progress in your preparations for labour, useful support measures in different stages of labour (including detailed discussion of a relaxation exercise), possible interventions Rachel Schwartzman, ND can offer you in pain management and other aspects of the birth, and preparation required at your home for the hospital. This appointment is normally scheduled in weeks 30 to 33 of pregnancy.

As a licensed naturopathic doctor, Rachel Schwartzman, ND may from time to time offer suggestions for healthy nutrition or natural approaches to common concerns of pregnancy. If more comprehensive naturopathic care is required for you or your newborn, a formal naturopathic intake may be scheduled and invoiced for separately from your doula care.

Labour and Birth:

You should contact Rachel Schwartzman, ND as soon as you think you are in labour, even if you do not think you require her services yet. She will give you recommendations by telephone until the appropriate time, at which point she will meet you (at your home or the hospital, depending on your birth plan). Rachel Schwartzman, ND will require approximately two hours to get to your location from the time you first contact her. Except under extraordinary circumstances, she (or the substitute doula – see below) will remain with you throughout the labour and birth.

As a licensed naturopathic doctor, Rachel Schwartzman, ND brings a kit of homeopathic and herbal medicines to all births she attends. If a situation arises in your labour where she feels a medicine is appropriate, she may recommend one. You are not obliged to accept the recommendation. If you know in advance you do not wish any homeopathic or herbal interventions, please advise Rachel Schwartzman, ND of this at the initial appointment.

Rachel Schwartzman, ND will remain with you for one or two hours after the birth, until you are comfortable and your family is ready for quiet time together. If necessary, she will provide support for first and second latch and review postpartum recovery at this time.

Postpartum home, hospital or telephone appointment:

The postpartum appointment with the parents and newborn is to review any questions or concerns you may have from your birth experience. Your recovery will be assessed and further recommendations to aid recovery will be made if necessary. At this time you will be asked to complete a short evaluation of Rachel Schwartzman, ND's performance at your birth. This appointment should be scheduled within seven days of the birth. Please telephone the office to schedule this appointment.

If desired, additional prenatal or postpartum appointments may be scheduled and will be invoiced separately from doula fees. In-office appointments cost \$75/30 minutes (plus HST) and \$130/60 minutes (all rates plus HST; contact the office for a detailed fee schedule). EXCLUSIONS FROM DOULA SERVICES

- Rachel Schwartzman, ND can not make treatment decisions for you. She will help you obtain the information necessary to make an informed decision and will bring to your attention departures from your birth plan, but you are responsible for determining all final treatment decisions
- Unless otherwise agreed upon in advance, Rachel Schwartzman, ND will not communicate to clinic staff (e.g., obstetrician, midwife, nurse) in your place on matters of decision making. She will discuss your concerns with you and suggest possible options, but you must communicate with clinic staff on your own behalf.

SUBSTITUTE DOULA

A substitute doula will be available in the event that Rachel Schwartzman, ND is unable to attend your birth (e.g., owing to illness) or if in the event of a very long labour a second doula is required. A meeting with your substitute doula can be arranged if you wish.

FAILURE TO PROVIDE SERVICE

Rachel Schwartzman, ND will make every effort to provide the services described here. Under certain circumstances this may not be possible (e.g., rapid labour). If failure to attend your birth is the result of error on Rachel Schwartzman, ND's part, you will be fully refunded the retaining fee (see below) and birth attendance fee (see below). If failure to attend your birth is the result of circumstances beyond Rachel Schwartzman, ND's control (e.g., rapid labour) or error on your part (e.g., failure to notify Rachel Schwartzman, ND of your labour in a timely fashion) you will be refunded the birth attendance fee but not the retaining fee. The birth attendance fee is fixed regardless of duration of the labour.

THIRD PARTY REIMBURSEMENT

As a licensed naturopathic doctor, Rachel Schwartzman, ND's services are covered by many extended healthcare plans. Consult your extended healthcare provider to confirm that naturopathic medicine or acupuncture is included in your coverage.

FEE SCHEDULE

The fee for the services described above is \$1200 (plus HST) to be paid as follows:

- \$600 (plus HST) retaining fee (for two prenatal in-office appointments and one postpartum home, telephone or hospital appointment) due at the first in-office appointment.
- \$600 (plus HST) birth attendance fee due at the second in-office appointment.
